

Lesson 2: Controlling the Flow of CI

SAMPLE SENTENCE

Write out a sentence you want to target. It can be from your script you wrote during the previous lesson or a new one. I suggest that you start with a simple sentence for the sake of practice. Example: *Bill wants an elephant.*

15 QUESTIONS

Write out 15 different questions based on your sample target sentence. You can write 'yes or no' questions, questions with a 'no' answer, questions with a 'yes' answer, open-ended questions, etc. To get to the 15-question mark, it helps to write questions about the subject, the verb, and the object of your sample sentence. Try to write a mix of them of the kinds of questions mentioned above.

Examples: *Does Bill want an elephant? (yes) Does Bill want a horse? (no) Does Bill want an elephant or a horse? (an elephant) Do I want an elephant? (yes/no) Who wants an elephant? (Bill)*
